

The **Invacare® APM™ Mattress Replacement System** is an easy to use alternating pressure mattress that aids in the prevention and treatment of Stage I to Stage IV pressure ulcers. This economical system does not compromise quality with price and is reliable with low maintenance.

Features

State of the art compressor - With solenoid valve system allows for easy set up and effective therapy cycles

Therapy time – Provides patient comfort and relief with 10 minute cycles

Constant pressure monitoring – Control unit constantly monitors the air pressure in the mattress to maintain the appropriate pressure to prevent capillary occlusion (generally below 32mm/Hg)

Pressure adjustment - Pressure can be adjusted by 25%, 50% or 75% to provide comfort for frail patients

Static mode - Alternating function ceases and pressure is redistributed across all cells within the mattress

Max firm mode - Assists during patient ingress/egress and initial set up

Audio and visual alarms - Warns patient and caregiver during power outage or low pressure

Power outage safety - Mattress remains inflated during power outage as long as air hose is connected to the compressor
