### assembly instructions

- Lay Top (#6) on table or floor with Top Support Bracket (#7) as shown
- 2. ELEVATE TRIP HANDLE (#8) TO APPROXIMATELY A 45°ANGLE. Insert Column (#4) into Top Support (#7), making sure the rectangular notches are aligned with the Top Bracket (#7) embossing (See Fig.2). Make sure that the Trip Handle (#8) tab is in the Trip channel in the Column (#4) (See Fig. 3). Fasten using 3/4" long bolts (#9) and lock washers (#10).
- 3. Lay the Base (#2) on a table or floor and install Casters (#3).
- Install Base (#2) to the Column (#4) with Casters pointing up. Tighten the hex-head bolts (#1) through the lock washers (#10) and base (#2).
- 5. Set the table upright on its casters.
- Remove the black shipping screw (#5) from front of Column (#4) and discard. Assembly is complete.






#### FIGURE 1




#### FIGURE 2

## operating instructions

#### TO ELEVATE THE TABLE:

Push upward at any position on the underside of the Top (#6), until the top has reached the desired height.

#### TO LOWER THE TABLE:

Squeeze the Trip Handle (#8) to release the column, and push down on the top (#6) until the desired height is reached.
