Directions For Application, Use and Care

Application

The Sling Seat Wheelchair Alarm System can be used in conjunction with the Drive Sensor Basic Alarm, and mounting bag to alert staff when a patient gets out of a wheelchair. When sitting on the sling seat, the alarm is inactive. When weight is removed, the alarm sounds, indicating the person may need assistance.

Installation

- 1. Remove existing fasteners and sling seat from chair frame (Figure 1).
- 2. Install new Sling Seat Alarm, and reinstall fasteners (Figure 2).
- 3. Connect Sling Seat Alarm to Sensor Basic Alarm. Sensor Basic Alarm can be mounted to wheelchair with the supplied mounting bag (Figure 3), or by use of the metal clip on the back of the unit (Figure 4).
